RE: Retriever Exploration Inc. – “Amaroktalik Project”
Request for “Use of Waters Without a Licence”

As per the Nunavut Waters Regulations, Sec. 3 (a)-(d), “Use of Waters Without a Licence”, I would like to request, on behalf of project owner Retriever Exploration Inc., (Retriever), permission to use water of approximately 1³ metre per day for camp-based exploration of the 100%-owned Amaroktalik Project. The request follows on Page 2.

The project will consist of first-pass exploration, collecting samples by foot traverse across the 576m³ claim block, which comprises 80% of NTS sheet 037A16, Central Baffin.

Mobilised from the FOX-3 radar-site airstrip (68° 39' N -- 71° 14' W) by Twin Otter, the programme will be supported from three movable tent camps, used successively for 9 days each by a 6-person team, between approximately 19 July and 16 August 2026.

As the claim block is wholly on Crown Land, Retriever also is applying for a Class B Land-Use Permit from the Nunavut Regional Office of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) under separate cover.

A copy of Retriever’s Project Description accompanies this request letter.
