Camp Location: 67° 07' 16" N, 112° 07' 43" W

Fuel Cache Location: 67° 08' 20" N, 112° 09' 32" W

Fuel Cache description: 3x drum of Jet A, no secondary containment, inaccessible in summer

Volume of human waste: 0.02 m³

Method of human waste disposal: burial

Estimated volume of water used: 0.16 m³
