As requested please find attached the following information related to use of land and water during the 2018 prospecting program in the Napaktulik Lake area and the Tree River area.

## Napaktulik Lake Area Camp

Camp Location: 66° 11′ 31" N, 112° 41′ 33" W

Volume of garbage produced: 0.1 m<sup>3</sup>

Method of garbage disposal: Removal from site

Volume of human waste: 0.02 m<sup>3</sup>

Method of human waste disposal: burial Estimated volume of water used: 0.16 m<sup>3</sup>

## **Tree River Area Camp**

Camp Location: 67° 07′ 16" N, 112° 07′ 43" W

Fuel Cache Location: 67° 08' 20" N, 112° 09' 32" W

Fuel Cache description: 3x drum of Jet A, no secondary containment, inaccessible in summer

Volume of garbage produced: 0.1 m<sup>3</sup>

Method of garbage disposal: Removal from site

Volume of human waste: 0.02 m<sup>3</sup>

Method of human waste disposal: burial Estimated volume of water used: 0.16 m<sup>3</sup>
