Background for Completeness Check

The Hamlet of Arviat's previous water license 3BM – ARV0308 expired on December 31, 2008. The Hamlet of Arviat contracted Nuna Burnside to complete an application for renewal in 2008. On December 23, 2008 Nuna Burnside completed a water license renewal application on behalf of the Hamlet of Arviat. The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) received that application on January 5, 2009. In a May 15, 2009 letter from the NWB to the Hamlet of Arviat, the NWB requested several additional documents to complete the water license renewal application. In an August 6, 2009 letter the NWB acknowledged receipt of the documents outlined in the previous letter. In a December 21, 2009 letter the NWB asked interested parties to comment on the completeness of the application and that a technical review of the water license application would continue sometime after January 11, 2010.

INAC has no issues with regards to the completeness of the application submitted by the Nuna Burnside on behalf of the Hamlet of Arviat. INAC will provide a technical review of the application upon NWB determination of a complete application.
