I have read the attached document and give permission on behalf of CIRNAC to initiate decant of the lagoon <u>immediately</u> to ensure the required freeboard. I understand that this is an emergency situation and ensuring stability of the infrastructure is required.

In the future steps need be taken in terms of monitoring throughout the year to prevent such an emergency situation from occurring again. This will allow discharging prior to the freeboard being within danger limits and proper notification to comply with the 10 day notice clause of the water licence.

The other conditions of the water licence must still be adhered to.
