Re: Application Acknowledgement for Chesterfield Inlet Quarry Development for Airport Rehabilitation Project Proposal

Dear Mr. Salgado and Mr. Desjardins:

The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) acknowledges receipt on January 26, 2006, of the above-cited Project Proposal from Transport Canada. Additional project related information for the development of a new quarry and the associated application from Government of Nunavut Department of Economic Development and Transportation arrived by email on February 16, 2006, from Mr. Desjardins.

Airport rehabilitation on its own is exempt from NIRB screening. However because the rehabilitation requires the development of a new quarry, which is an industrial activity requiring a NIRB screening, the whole project will be screened. NIRB has assigned this Project Proposal file number, 06QN014. All documents received and pertaining to this Project Proposal can be obtained from NIRB's ftp site at 06QN014-Nunavut Airports Division, Chesterfield Inlet including:

This said, NIRB reserves the right to request additional information at any time during the process. NIRB will copy you on the screening process related correspondence and upload related documents to the above ftp site for Public access.
