Good Morning Nick, will you be conducting a study on Chesterfield similar to the one on Baker Lake? I am also interested in timelines for any additional information that may come in. Also will you be involved with the proposed road to Josephine Lake?

For you information I have included a list of what the water board is looking for pertaining to road construction:

- 1. Evidence of an application for a Land Use Permit from the Kivalliq Inuit Association if on Inuit Owned Land.
- 2. Evidence of an application for a Land Use Permit from Indian and Northern Affairs if crossing Crown Land.
- 3. A Culvert Bridge Questionnaire (previously e-mailed) will be required as the road will likely cross Josephine River which contains migratory Arctic Char.
- 4. A detailed map of the proposed road route including topography and adjacent water bodies.
- 5. 90% Complete signed and stamped engineering diagrams for any bridges along the proposed road to Josephine Lake.
