RE: 3BM-COR1521 Renewal and Amendment Application

Dear Richard,

The Municipality of Coral Harbour is pleased to submit the renewal and amendment application for 3BM COR-1521 water license with the understanding that a Type A license is required. The licensee is requesting a 10-year term. The 45,000 m³ allowable annual limit of withdrawal from Post River is expected to support the municipality given the current rate of consumption and anticipated population growth. The licensee is also requesting that review of this application be coordinated with the concurrent Nunavut Impact Review Board review.

In this application the licensee is requesting to amend the daily limit of water pumped from Post River to up to 2,000 m³/day, while maintaining the current annual limit of 45,000 m³ annually. This is to reflect that water is pumped from Post River during the open water season to a raw water reservoir to be used for the year.
