Dear Bryan:

The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on September 12, 2003 of your water license amendment application, filed in joint venture with the Hamlet of Coral Harbour, for the fencing and berm of the sewage deposit area. Your application included the following items:

- Cover letter stamped September 12, 2003
- Project description in English AND Inuktitut
- Application form
- Supplementary questionnaire
- Maps and drawings
- Application fee

The application fee is being returned to the Hamlet of Coral Harbour since the payee must be "Receiver General for Canada" and not "Nunavut Water Board."

This project is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) and from review by the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC), due to its municipal status, and will be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a notice of your application is required. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take "...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings]."

Accordingly, a notice in both English and Inuktitut will be posted for a period of 30 days, with local establishments in Coral Harbour. Copy of the notice will be available to you during the distribution process.
