Hi Don;

We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated October 23, 2009.

The Dept. of Community & Government Services is aware of the recharge rate of Nipisar Lake. CGS has awarded a contract to a consultant for a water consumption audit & leak detection survey to try & determine where all the water is going. We have also conducted a bathymetric survey of the lake to determine the actual volume. The water level in the lake seems to have dropped about 2.5 feet in recent years.

We are also investigating the option of installing an over land seasonal pipe line and pumping water from another lake into Nipisar Lake.

CGS is requested that Nunavut Water Board proceed with the water license renewal as submitted. If further action is required to replenish the community water supply CGS may seek an amendment to the license when the above mention studies are completed and a course of action is more defined.
