Hi David,

Thanks you for copying me on this letter. Is the Board considering sending the request made by CGS for a two year extension to the Minister for approval? As you mention in your letter, the Board is limited to issuing a short term renewal to extend the expiry of an existing license to 180 days, a decision that is still subject to the Minister. It would appear that if the intention is to keep the Rankin Inlet Type A license in good standing, an extension of more that 180 days would be required considering all the steps involved in the renewal process. The Minister has indicated in recent correspondence to the Board that he wishes the NWB and departmental officials work together to keep licenses in good standing. If the Minister was to consider extending the license for up to 2 years, it would take the pressure off the Board in terms of more reasonable time lines for issuing the license, but it would also relieve pressure on Field Operations. If the license expires in November we'll be left to react to the expiry of a high profile Type A license with limited enforcement options on our end. I understand that extending the license beyond 180 days involves a public hearing which is time consuming, yet I think we should explore any option available to us to keep this license in good standing.
