Hello,

I am requesting information on the status of the NIRB screening for the 3AM-GRA1015 GN-CGS Hamlet of Rankin Inlet Type "A" Renewal Water Licence Application. On March 27, 2015 Robin Ikkutisluk of the NWB distributed the attached email with letter attachment requesting that the NPC and NIRB conduct their reviews of the project.

On April 1, 2015 Brian Aglukark of the NPC provided the second attached email which stated that the NPC reviewed the 3AM-GRA1015 GN-CGS Hamlet of Rankin Inlet Type "A" Renewal Water Licence Application and determined that it conforms to the Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan. The NWB and NIRB were cc'd in this correspondence.

As outlined in the Renewal Application cover letter, the NIRB issued a screening decision for the 3AM-GRA1015 Amendment Application for the seasonal replenishment of Nipissar Lake on June 26, 2014. During the last Water Licence renewal process, the NIRB stated the application was exempt from screening in an email from Ryan Barry (NIRB) to Phyllis Beaulieu (NWB), dated March 16, 2010. These documents were included with the current Renewal Application and can be provided upon request. An updated decision from the NIRB is needed to process the Renewal Application.
