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Dear Ms. Lusty:

On April 30, 2015, Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) Water Resource Officers, Field Operations met with you at your office in Rankin Inlet to discuss compliance objectives for the water licence 3AM-GRA1015. As a result of this meeting it was determined that many of the requirements included in the 'multi-year municipal compliance summary' provided by AANDC in 2012 had been met. It was also noted during the meeting that many of the requirements from recent inspections had also been met.

## **Determination**

It has been determined by AANDC that any relevant items not mentioned in this document as 'outstanding items' that were not submitted as required in a water licence, compliance requirements in previous inspections reports, or mentioned in the 'multi-year municipal compliance summary' have either been fulfilled or are being fulfilled through the Municipal Water Licence Compliance Working Group initiative which includes Municipal, Government of Nunavut and Federal Government representative involvement or through a water licence renewal/amendment with the Nunavut Water Board.

To this end, AANDC has determined that it is not in the public interest to pursue further action beyond the items initiated through the Municipal Water Licence Compliance Working Group and the items listed below.

## **Outstanding Items**

AANDC requests that the following requirements are met and will be verified during the 2015 municipal inspection season:

- 1. Temporary signage to be posted in spring 2015 at all water monitoring sites until such time as the permanent signs are installed.
- 2. Record book or 'tally sheet' to be utilized to record estimates of sewage sludge leaving site. The results will be included in reporting requirements of the current water licence.
- 3. Copies of QA/QC manuals are required to be placed in the pump house.
