
Good afternoon,

The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt May 27, 2021 of the notification of wastewater leak and request for bypass during repair, the discharge bypassing treatment by the Sewage Treatment Plant will be directly into marine environment where the Board does not have direct jurisdiction, Board approval will still be required for as per Part D, Item 1 of Licence 3AM-GRA1624: "direct all Sewage to the Sewage Treatment Facility or as otherwise approved by the Board".
