Re: Application for Water Licence
Hamlet of Igloolik

Further to your letter of May 14, 1979, the following is the information you requested to update the original Water Licence Application dated February 3, 1977. Please consider this application as being jointly submitted by the Hamlet and by the G.N.W.T. since the latter is responsible for the capital cost and the O/M of the water/sewer infrastructure. The Water Licence should reflect the joint nature of this application.

WATER SUPPLY

The water supply system is being upgraded this construction season. The improvements to be undertaken are:

- a) Construction of a 30,000 M³ reservoir by rock excavation from Airport Lake.
- b) Construction of a pumphouse/truck fill station adjacent to the reservoir.
- c) Construction of a summer above ground intake line from South Lake to the reservoir.

Further details of these improvements can be found in the attached report entitled "Water Supply System - Hamlet of Igloolik" dated March, 1979. Only one copy of this report is available at this time.

The Hamlet approved the proposed improvements in the April 11, 1979 Council meeting.

Construction of the reservoir has already begun. Completion

Honeybags and pump-out sewage are deposited at the garbage dump (see map # 1 attached).

A Predesign Report of available alternatives for improved sewage treatment /disposal facilities is scheduled for this summer.
