Further to your conversation with Mrs. Munro regarding submission of plans and reports in support of water use applications, this will confirm that the following is required for each application.

Applications for Communities of Hamlet Status and Over

Application (in duplicate) signed by Chairman or Secretary Manager (unless the Council has authorized G.N.W.T. to make the application on their behalf).

12 copies of Technical Reports and Plans.

If these are not readily available please submit 2 copies of report plus sepia's of plans, so that copies can be made.

\$10.00 application fee (to Receive General of Canada).)

Application for Communities of less than Hamlet Status

Application in duplicate by G.N.W.T.
6 copies of Technical Reports and Plans
(or 2 copies plus sepia's)
(no application fee required)

If the project is to be substantially changed from the initial application a new one should be submitted, but no further application fee will be required unless the licence or authorization has already been issued.

It would be appreciated if 11 further copies of the Report "Water Supply System - Hamlet of Igloolik" could be submitted, or as many copies as are available plus sepias.
