Dear Mr. Cook

Re: Water licence application for Hydrostatic Tank Testing in Igloolik.

Sorry for the delay in getting back on your questions concerning Igloolik. I have been in the South working with our Liner division and I did not receive your letter till now.

Concerning your questions:

- 1-All tanks are cleaned of any sludge and fuel after the tanks are emptied for modification. We use a pressure washer to clean the side walls and all waste is taken to the local landfill for burning and any remaining residue after burning is buried.
- 2- 1 new 3300 M3
 - 1 new 1500 M3
 - 2 used 1400 M3 used for diesel fuel.
 - 7 used 95 M3 used for gasoline.
- 3- I do not see a problem with the water flow from our water source as it flowed all last year and never seemed to let up. If there is a problem we would have to use sea water.
- 4-There are no other drainage sources in the immediate area as the entire area is a pourous gravel terrain and any water that falls is immediatly drained away. The ocean is 1 Kilometer away on the oppisite side of the tank farm that the runway is.
- 5-There is no wildlife that uses this runoff source as the water immediatly dissapears into the gravel as it drains from the culvert under the runway.
- 6-The testwater will be discharged into a lined sump that we will build to the side of the tank farm for holding untill we can confirm there is no contaminates in the test water. As we see there are no contaminates we will drain the sump onto the gravel landscape for drainage.
- 7- See attached map.
- 8- All water will be recycled between tanks which means we will need to draw 3300 M3 from the water source.
