you can assume the settlement dump.

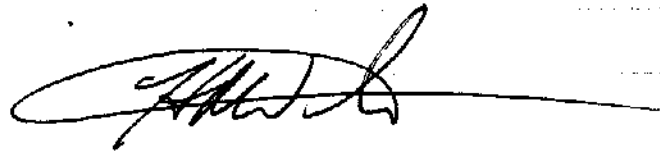
In winter if weather is too bad to get
