Dear Dionne,

Regrettably I will not be attending the Nunavut Water Board Public Hearing - Application for licence for the Hamlet of Igloolik.

The most relevant projects are the Water Reservoir Expansion and the Sewage Lagoon Expansion. Michele Bertol in our office oversees these projects as they are being funded by the Nunavur Incremental Infrastructure Program. Unfortunately she is travelling and unable to attend as well.

In our first conversation regarding this event you suggested MACA take the opportunity to inform the community about the Water Reservoir Expansion and the Setvage Treatment Facility Expansion. The project officer from PW&S and the consultant retained to study the existing facilities and examine methods of expansion will be in Igloolik on Monday, February 16. They are meeting with the Hamlet Council for this very purpose. The Project Officer, David Parker, P.Eng. has agreed to stay in igloolik until the Nunavut Water Board Hearing to deliver a short presentation on the proposed expansion of both facilities.

I have offered him my return seat on the charter to accommodate his extended stay. I hope this is an acceptable arrangement.
