Good afternoon,

In response to recently issued guidance from public health authorities restricting all public gatherings across Nunavut in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, and as requested by the Applicant, the Hamlet of Igloolik on November 13, 2020, the Nunavut Water Board has made the decision to cancel the in-person Public Hearing scheduled to take place in Igloolik on December 8 and 9, 2020, associated with the Board's consideration of the Hamlet of Igloolik's Application for a New Type "A" Water Licence No: 3AM-IGL---- to authorize the Hamlet's continued water use and deposit of waste associated with a municipal undertaking.

In order to ensure the health and safety of the community of Igloolik and all participants in the Board's Public Hearing process, the Board's decision-making Panel for the file has directed that the form of Public Hearing be modified from the originally scheduled In-person Public Hearing to a Written Public Hearing.

To reflect the change in format, the Board directs that the Applicant and Intervenors participating in the written Public Hearing comply with the following timelines:

- On or before November 26, 2020 the Intervenors must file their final written submissions and any closing arguments they wish the Board to consider in decision-making in respect of the Application;
- On or before December 3, 2020 the Applicant must file their final written submission and any closing arguments they wish the Board to consider in decision-making in respect of the Application;
- Once all submissions have been received and reviewed by the Board, the NWB will determine whether the Board has received all information required to proceed to decision-making, and if so, the Board will provide notice that the Public Hearing Record is closed and will remit the matter to the NWB's decision-making Panel for their decision
