A. BACKGROUND

The Government of Nunavut Community and Government Services (GN-CGS) manages the Nunavut Water Board water licence for the Hamlet of Igloolik, which permits Municipal Undertakings including potable water withdrawals and storage, operation of truck fill stations, wastewater collection and treatment, and the operation of waste management sites. The Hamlet of Igloolik 2020 Annual Report provides information on project activities for the Hamlet of Igloolik from January to December, 2020, as required by Part B Item 1 of Water Licence No. 3BM-IGL1520. In 2020, the Hamlet of Igloolik applied to amend and renew Type B Water Licence No. 3BM-IGL1520 and were issued Type A Water Licence No. 3AM-IGL2131 on January 12, 2021. No project activities are being reported under the amended Type A water licence.

CIRNAC provides the following comment and recommendation pertaining to the 2020 Annual Report. Documents reviewed as part of this submission can be found in Table 1 of Section B. Detailed technical review comments can be found in Section C. References are in Section D.

C. RESULTS OF REVIEW

1. Monitoring Program Reporting Requirements

Comment:

Part B Item 1b. of water licence 3BM-IGL1520 outlines the requirement for tabular summaries of all data generated under the "Monitoring Program" to be included in the Annual Report. Part H of the licence describes the details of the Monitoring Program. These requirements have not been fully met in the 2020 Annual Report. The following details have not been provided:

IGL-1 and IGL-1a: Water volumes were reported in litres for South Lake and Fish Lake, as a combined total; volumes were not separated by water source.

IGL-2: Part H Item 4 states that the Licensee shall sample at station IGL-2 once at the beginning, middle and near the end of discharge or run-off observed. Two samples of three were reported on July 13 and 23, 2020.

IGL-4: Flow from one cell of three was reported in September. (If this was the only cell for which there was flow in September, this should be noted in the Annual Report).

IGL-5: Not reported.

Recommendation:

(R-01) CIRNAC recommends that GN-CGS provide the monitoring information required under Part H of water licence 3BM-IGL1520, or provide rationale for why this information has not been reported.
