Thank you for the March 3, 2021 invitation to review the referenced updated Spill Contingency Plan (SCP) and Wastewater Treatment Facility Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Manual for the Hamlet of Igloolik, Type A Water Licence No. 3AM-IGL2131. Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) examined the submission pursuant to its mandated responsibilities under the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act and the Department of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Act.

In the Final Written Submission for the Hamlet of Igloolik Water Licence Amendment, dated October 29, 2020, CIRNAC requested that the following be included in an updated SCP:

- the size and storage capacity of each sewage lagoon; and
- a site photo indicating the location(s) where spill kits are stored.

In the Final Written Submission for the Hamlet of Igloolik Water Licence Amendment, dated October 29, 2020, CIRNAC requested that the following be included in an updated O&M Manual for the Wastewater Treatment Facility:

- the pathway to access the monitoring stations at the filter strip wetland;
- the locations of safety equipment and spill kits on site;
- the snow accumulation and dumping areas;
- a north arrow on maps to aid in directional instructions; and
- the procedure for measuring wastewater volumes decanted from the lagoons.
