Sewage trucks were called to the site to pump down the level of sewage in Access Vault (AV) 415. The hot water blaster was then used to blast the line and free the blockage. A loader and a tandem truck were used to clean up the sewage that had saturated the surrounding snow and the affected snow was brought to the sewage lagoon.</b>
