K	Two Sewage trucks from the city were called in immediately to pump out AV 262. The spill was contained to an area on the Government of Nunavut Airport Land and Nunavut Excavating was called in to clean up contaminated area. Nunavut Excavating brought in an Excavator and several dump trucks to spill site and removed 113 loads of contaminated snow and ice which was hauled to the Sewage lagoon. The City used their Blaster to remove the blockage which was located between AV-261 and AV-262, the line was blasted and cleared. An open ended sewage pipe on the Airport property was why the sewage pooled in this area. This pipe was capped off to prevent any further reacurrances. Clean-up was at all times contained to this area, and completed on March 23, 2010 by Nunavut Excavating under the supervision of the City of Iqaluit.
