
Quarry Operation and Management

5. The scope of the water licence should be amended to include the development, operation, and closure of quarries. Consequently, the renewed water licence should include applicable terms and conditions specific to the use of water and deposit of waste into or near water.

*Response: The City contends that the operation of a quarry typically does not involve the use of water or the deposition of waste into or near water, and as such the operation of a quarry should not be licenced under the NWB water licence. The City agrees with conditions pertaining to water use and deposit of waste as they pertain to operations of a quarry.*
