Further to our discussion on Friday, thank you for providing clarification on the application review process. I understand that the Technical Meeting (TM), Pre-Hearing Conference (PHC), and Public Information Session (Public Meeting) are intended to provide information for the NWB to make a decision on whether a Public Hearing is required prior to issuing a water licence. Per this understanding, the City will provide a brief presentation of its application during the TM, PHC, and Public Meeting. The intent will be to give a high level overview of the application, identifying what is included and what is not included, and to identify the

documents provided as part of the application.

In addition, from our conversation, I understand that the NWB will be making the logistical arrangements for the TM, PHC, and Public Meeting, which will include translation services and tech support (e.g. projector, sound, laptop, etc.). Could you please confirm this?
