## RE: NPC File # 149227 [Kudlik north 40 area assessment, explosive cache (K5), granular crushing plant (k1) and concrete batch plant (K6)]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

- 1. Updating authorizations due to the transfer of GN CGS lands in North40 area of Iqaluit to City of Iqaluit. All operations are previously licensed and will not change.
- 2. Location: Qikiqtani Region; [North40 Iqaluit]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. The NPC has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan, and the works and activities listed above were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board including explosives cache and concrete plant, (NIRB FILE NO.: 14UN008).

This project proposal is exempt from the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (NUPPAA) under section 235 of that Act. The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that scope of the original project activities is not changing, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.
