Subject: Harvesting water from Apex river for Iqaluit

Just a comment on the town of Iqaluit wanting to pump water from the Apex river until the year 2026.

It is my opinion that they will have to extend beyond this date in the long term as the Town is only going to get bigger in those years and they have done nothing to implement water saving schemes.

I personally have written to the mayor regarding making it mandatory to install dual flush toilets in new buildings, and to start a retrofit program in installing new dual flush toilets in old buildings.

I have also suggested to the Mayor and supplied her with system plans where they could recycle bath and shower water and use this water for flushing toilets.

In all I would estimate a saving of at least one third of their current water usage and that would mean that they would not need to pump from the Apex river at all
