As you know, I am a member of the Nunavut Department of Justice, Legal Division. We are providing legal advice and assistance the Government of Nunavut, Department of Sustainable Development regarding their written submissions that you requested in the matter of the Iqaluit Municipal Water License.

Further to our telephone discussion yesterday, I am advised that the dates issued by the Water Board for written submissions are October 12<sup>th</sup> for the initial submission, and October 26<sup>th</sup> for replies.

I also understand you have received a request from Mr. Earle Badalloo for a brief adjournment of those dates. I am writing to you, to make a second request for adjournment. I would ask that you kindly convey this request to the Board in the most appropriate way.

From the perspective of the Nunavut Department of Justice, Legal Division this is a new file. Our advisory role has involved and will continue to involve chasing down a variety of exhibits located in Iqaluit, co-ordinating involved government parties in both the NWT and Nunavut, and conducting careful consultations within the new Government of Nunavut where the issues of Burning and these License submissions generally, have not previously received detailed attention.

We hope that you will be willing to grant our request for an adjournment of approximately three (3) weeks, in order to complete this work and provide the Board with a thorough and careful written submission. Thank you in advance for your attention to this matter,
