RE: Scope Clarification of Renewal Application for Water Licence 3AM-IQA0612

Dear Mr. Kharatyan:

On January 13th and 14th, 2016, representatives of the City of Iqaluit attended the Technical Meeting, Public Meeting and Pre-Hearing Conference for the renewal application of Water Licence 3AM-IQA0612. Resulting from these meetings was a number of commitments made by the City of Iqaluit, principal of which was the provision of a summary letter clarifying the scope of the renewal application, as there had been a number of additions and deletions to the scope since the original renewal application was submitted in October of 2012.

The following summarizes the current scope of the application and the items withdrawn from the scope as discussed at the meetings identified above.

Current Scope

1. Proposed maximum annual withdrawal of 1,100,000 m³ from Lake Geraldine to the City of Iqaluit Water Treatment Plant;
2. Upgrade, operation and the eventual decommissioning of the infrastructure for managing wastewater at the existing West 40 Wastewater Treatment Plant and backup Sewage Lagoon;
3. Operation and the eventual decommissioning of the infrastructure for managing surface water run-off at the solid waste management facility at the existing West 40 Landfill;
4. Changes to the Monitoring Program (to be provided on February 5, 2016, per the commitment schedule resulting from the January 13-14 meetings); and
5. Request to extend the length of the term of the licence to ten (10) years.

Items Withdrawn from Scope

1. Construction, operation and the eventual decommissioning of a surface water management infrastructure associated with a new solid waste management facility approximately 7.5 kilometers northwest of Iqaluit City Center.
2. Construction, operation and the eventual decommissioning of an additional location for water extraction to supplement Lake Geraldine from Apex River.
3. Construction, operation and eventual decommissioning of a new quarry.
