### **Notice of Public Hearing**

The Nunavut Water Board's **public hearing** for the Town of Iqaluit's municipal water licence will take place at the following:

**Date:** **November 22**, 2000 from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

**November 23**, 2000 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

**November 24**, 2000 from 9 a.m. until closing of the hearing

**Location:** St. Jude's Parish Hall, Iqaluit

Everyone is invited to attend. Transportation to and from Parish Hall will be provided by the Board at the beginning and end of each day, as well as for lunch and dinner breaks. The bus service will start half an hour before starting time. It will follow this route:

- 1) Abe Opik Hall in Apex
- 2) Joami School
- 3) DFO in Tundra Valley
- 4) House #2533 in Tundra Valley
- 5) House #446 in Happy Valley
- 6) House #411 in Happy Valley
- 7) House #588 in Happy Valley
- 8) House #275 in the Graveyard Area
- 9) Paris Hall

The public hearing will also include a site visit to the municipal infrastructures on **November 23, 2000** leaving from St. Jude's Parish Hall at 10:00 a.m.

The hearing will be conducted in both Inuktitut and English.

The following issues will be the subject of the NWB hearing:

- 1) the use of water for municipal purposes, and in particular the Town's long-term water supply and the integrity and stability of Lake Geraldine's dam;
- 2) the status of the new sewage treatment plant;
- 3) the disposal of sludge that will be produced by the new sewage treatment plant;
- 4) the status of the current sewage lagoon, including the stability of its dykes and its decommissioning;
- 5) the current and proposed methods for solid waste disposal, including the operation of the current solid waste disposal facility and appropriate contingency during the transition period from the current method to the proposed method;
- 6) the abandonment and restoration of the current and other solid waste disposal sites in Iqaluit.

Others issues within NWB's jurisdiction may arise before and during the public hearing.
