Issue: Sewage and Effluent Treatment Facilities

- Applicant has stated they will not be in compliance with sub-section 36(3) of the Fisheries Act.
- Sub-section 36(3) is a direct prohibition against depositing a deleterious substance into fish frequented waters. There is no permit or licence that will allow this activity – it can only be “approved” through a regulation.
- No regulation currently exists to allow for this type of deposit.



Issue: Sewage and Effluent Treatment Facilities

Recommendation:

- The City make a commitment to move towards compliance with the Fisheries Act.
- Within 3 months of issuance of a water licence the City produce a plan outlining how they might proceed with the development of Phase II of the Sewage Treatment Plant including timelines for construction and identification of potential funding sources.
