The NWB

- > is an Institution of Public
 Government (IPG) established
 under Article 13 of the
 Nunavut Agreement
- > has responsibilities and powers over the regulation, use, and management of freshwater in the Nunavut Settlement Area



Pobjects of the NWB are to provide for the conservation and utilization of waters in Nunavut, except in a national park, in a manner that will provide the optimum benefit from those waters for Nunavut's residents in particular, and Canadians in general.



- Nunavut Waters Regulations (Regulations), the NWB may issue any of the following authorizations for the use of water and/or deposit of waste for undertakings in Nunavut:
- Approval without a
 Licence (less than 50 m³
 per day water required)



Scope of Application

- Application before the Board is by the City of Iqaluit related to the use of water, and the supplementation of their freshwater reservoir.
