Hello,

The City of Iqaluit has been out of compliance with their water licence since January 13, 2018, to avoid any potential enforcement action please provide INAC and the NWB with the reports required under PART E, Item 16 of the water licence 3AM-IQA1626.

Failure to comply with this Licence shall be a violation of the Act, subjecting the Licensee to the enforcement measures and the penalties provided for in the Act. The Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act (the Act) States that:

- 90. (1) Any person who contravenes subsection 11(1) or section 12, or fails to comply with subsection 11(3) or with a direction given by an inspector under subsection 87(1), is quilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or to both.
- (2) A licensee holding a type A licence who
- (a) contravenes any condition of the licence, where the contravention does not constitute an offence under section 91, or

(b) fails, without reasonable excuse, to furnish or maintain security as required under subsection 76(1) is guilty of an
offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100,000 or to imprisonment for a term not
exceeding one year, or to both.

Hello,

During the last emergency decant, November 17, 2017. I Informed Maria Karveli and Matthew Hamp of the City of Igaluit's requirements described in Part E of the water licence 3AM-IQA1626.

During the emergency decant in 2017 the City of Igaluit failed to give the appropriate notice prior to the decant and to provide the report 60 days after the emergency Decant. Please Provide the report by the end of January 2018 to myself and the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) as required.

During this emergency decant the City of Igaluit has only given 2 days notice when, 15 days it the requirement. Ensure that 60 days Prior to this emergency decant a report is submitted to myself and the NWB.

Please ensure all employees who are responsible for the deposit of waste understand the City of Iqaluit's obligations described in the Water Licence 3AM-IQA1626.

Below I have provided the requirements in PART E of the water licence 3AM-IQA1626 and the correspondence from November 18, 2017, if you have any questions or concerns please contact me with the information below.

## PART E: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO THE DEPOSIT OF WASTE AND WASTE MANAGEMENT **PLANS**

2. The Licensee shall provide written notice to an Inspector and the Board at least ten (10) days prior to any planned Discharges from the Solid Waste Facility, Sewage Lagoon Facility, Wastewater Treatment Plant, and the Upgraded

Wastewater Treatment Plant once commissioned.

- 15. The Inspector may authorize an emergency Discharge ,following the Licensee's written submission to the Inspector and to the Board, at least fifteen (15) days prior to discharge or as instructed by the Inspector, that includes the following information:
- a. Proposed quantity of discharge;
- b. Reason for discharge;
- c. Identification of the Final Discharge Location;
- d. Proposed sampling and analysis to be conducted; and
- e. Proposed mitigation measures to implemented.
- 16. The Licensee shall submit to the Board and the Inspector for review, within sixty (60) days following any emergency Discharge authorized by the Inspector, a report that includes, among other items, an analysis of results for the emergency Discharge.
