



Although the three Iqaluit Waste Project items will not be ready for submission for the August 30th deadline, considerable progress has been made on each of these items. The first edit of the draft Abandonment and Restoration Plan and second edit of the draft Operation and Maintenance Manual have been completed. The Solid Waste Management Plan is also nearing completion. The final project Newsletter (attached to this letter) containing the proposed Solid Waste Management Plan was distributed to residents in June. In July, the final Open House was held followed by a consultation with the City's Engineering Committee of the Whole, which is made up of all members of Council.

In order to follow up with the issues brought forward from the July consultations and the editing process, the City requires more time to complete three outstanding Solid Waste Project items.

The City is working toward submitting all three Solid Waste Project items to the Nunavut Water Board on or before November 30, 2013. As a result, the City is requesting that the NIRB deadline for submitting the Hazardous Waste Management Plan (will be included in the new Solid Waste Management Plan), Abandonment and Restoration Plan and NIRB Part 2 Form be moved to November 30, 2013.
