The sewage truck crew notified their foreman and the utilidor crew of the situation, just as they started pumping sewer from the access vault. While the utilidor crew prepared their sewer blaster for blasting the sanitary from AV301, which is further down the road from AV300. At about the same time, proper measures were taken to control traffic in the area by the municipal enforcement. The road crew has been notified to cleanup the affected area.</b>
