Dear Sir:

It has come to my attention that our water license requires notification to be given to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) when modifications are being made to our water supply.

We are currently expanding the capacity of our potable water treatment plant to meet the increasing population of Iqaluit until approximately the year 2022.

Our current plant was designed with a production capacity of approximately 1,000 cubic meters/day. Currently we use approximately 1,500 cubic meters/day. As such, the current treatment plant is operating over design capacity.

The new plant will have a capacity to produce approximately 9,500 cubic meters of treated water per day which is our estimated requirement for the year 2022. The treatment process will be similar to the existing system with the addition of ultraviolet disinfection and a change from lime to caustic soda for pH adjustment.
