On behalf of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC), I have reviewed the above mentioned modification of the City of Igaluit's municipal water licence to allow for the replacement of a failed culvert on Allunga Road. The following advice has been provided pursuant to INAC's mandated responsibilities for the enforcement of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act (NW&NSRT) and the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development Act (DIAND Act).

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada is supportive of the City of Iqaluit's intention to replace the failed culvert on Allunga Road. The City of Igaluit should ensure that all terms and conditions established in its Type A water licence, particulary Part G: Conditions Applying to Modifications, are followed.

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada requests notification of any changes in the proposed project, as further review may be necessary.
