The City of Iqaluit relies upon the Lake Geraldine Dam to act as a reservoir for its drinking water supply and as such, considers the Dam to be a integral part of the potable Water Treatment Facilities. As a result of previous Dam Inspections, it has been noted that certain Lake Geraldine Dam repairs are necessary under the high water line of the Lake Geraldine Dam. The City has retained Concentric Engineering to develop these repair requirements and to prepare contract documents that would allow this repair work to be completed during July and August 2018.

We have reviewed the City's Type “A” Water Licence No. 3AM-IQA1626 and consider this work to be subject to Part G of our Licence, that is, Conditions Applying to Modifications. The City has come to this determination based upon the assessment that:

- The proposed modifications will not change land use and are therefore, are consistent with NPC Land Use Planning,
- These Modifications do not place the Licensee in contravention of this License or the Act;

On this basis, the City is proceeding with the proposed Lake Geraldine Dam Underwater Repair contract and is hereby providing the NWB with (60) days advanced notification of this project as required by work subject to Part G of the Licence.

Also in conformance with Part G of the Licence, the City will provide as built drawings of the completed repairs within ninety (90) days of the completion of the project. These drawings will be stamped by a professional engineer.
