As discussed yesterday evening, the City will proceed with these activities as a Modification as per Part G Item 1 of the Licence.

As further discussed, given the emergency declaration by the Minister of Community and Government Services (CGS) on October 13, 2021, the City is seeking to expedite the review of this modification request under Section 152 (1) of the Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NuPA) – I understand this would bypass the NPC conformity determination and NIRB's screening decision. Although the initial emergency declaration has expired, I understand that the Minister of CGS had extended the emergency declaration on October 28th until November 9th.
