As discussed yesterday evening, the City will proceed with these activities as a Modification as per Part G Item 1 of the Licence.

As further discussed, given the emergency declaration by the Minister of Community and Government Services (CGS) on October 13, 2021, the City is seeking to expedite the review of this modification request under Section 152 (1) of the Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NuPA) – I understand this would bypass the NPC conformity determination and NIRB's screening decision. Although the initial emergency declaration has expired, I understand that the Minister of CGS had extended the emergency declaration on October 28<sup>th</sup> until November 9<sup>th</sup>. On behalf of the City of Iqaluit, the City would like to notify the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) regarding the planned deployment of a Reverse Osmosis Water Purification Unit (ROWPU), which is being managed and overseen by the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) Joint Task Force North (JTFN) division. This comes following a Request-For-Assistance issued by the Government of Nunavut (GN) on October 20, 2021, in response to the on-going water quality emergency.

As per Part F item 1 of the Licence (3AM-IQA1626), the City is required to notify the NWB of construction of any facilities or infrastructure authorized under this Licence. Please consider this email as formal notification of the planned deployment of the CAF ROWPU. I have attached relevant information pertaining to the project for reference purposes.

Please note, the City will be issuing a separate notification related to the planned deployment of a GN mobile water treatment plant (MWTP); however, the City is still awaiting further information from the GN regarding the project. Note, the deployment of the GN MWTP is also in response to the on-going water quality emergency.
