Subject: Type A Water Licence No: 3AM-IQA1626 – City of Iqaluit Project; Short Term Renewal

Dear Honourable Minister Chartrand,

Please find enclosed, for your review and approval, the Nunavut Water Board's (NWB or Board) Decision regarding a Short Term Renewal Application (STR Application) filed by the City of Iqaluit (City or Applicant) under s. 9(1)(b) of the *Nunavut Waters Regulations*,¹ SOR/2013-69 (*Regulations*) seeking the short term renewal (up to 180 days) of type A Water Licence No: 3AM-IQA1626 (the Existing Water Licence) which is set to expire on June 16, 2026. The purpose of the STR Application is to ensure that if the NWB's and the Minister's consideration of City's application for the long-term (20 year requested by City) renewal of the Existing Water Licence (full Renewal Application) is not completed by June 16, 2026, the Short-Term Renewal Water Licence (STR Water Licence) will bridge the gap between the expiry of the Existing Water Licence and completion of the NWB's and Minister's consideration and decision-making in relation to the full Renewal Application (and if recommended by the NWB and approved by the Minister, the issuance of a long-term renewed licence).

As set out in more detail in the attached Decision, the Existing Water Licence was issued to the City by the NWB on June 17, 2016, and was subsequently approved by the Minister on July 19, 2016. The Applicant filed an application for the full renewal of the Existing Water Licence on December 31, 2025. Since the NWB is bound by the timelines set in the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* (*NWNSRTA* or *Act*) for the processing of a type A application,

the issuance of the full renewal licence may not be possible before the expiry of the Existing Water Licence. Therefore, the NWB advised the City to submit an STR Application to bridge any potential gap between the expiry of the Existing Water Licence and the issuance and approval of the long-term renewed licence.

On March 13, 2026 the Board received the STR Application from the City requesting a short-term renewal of the Existing Water Licence on the following basis:

- No changes to the Existing Water Licence (administrative or otherwise) are being requested by the City of Iqaluit;
- The term of the STR Water Licence would not exceed 180 days from the date on which the Existing Water Licence expires (June 16, 2026), and the STR Water Licence would expire on the earlier of December 13, 2026 OR the Minister's completion of decision-making for the full Renewal Application (and if approved by the Minister, the issuance of a long-term renewed licence);
- No plans, studies, reports, or designs would be submitted in support of the STR Application as this information has already been provided, or will be provided during the Board's processing of the full Renewal Application; and
- The NWB's consideration of the full renewal application would continue in as timely and efficient manner as possible.

The NWB published notice of the STR Application on March 16, 2026 and commenced a thirty (30) day technical review period, which closed on April 15, 2026. No comments, other than confirmation that parties did not have comments, were received in relation to the STR Application by the deadline. On April 17, 2026, by **Motion No: 2026-01-P6-03**, the duly appointed three-member Panel of the Board (Panel P6) responsible for dealing with the City of Iqaluit type A Water Licence, including the STR Application, authorized the issuance of the STR Water Licence upon receipt of Nunavut Planning Commission confirmation of conformity, which only amends the Expiry Date of the Existing Water Licence, adding a further term of up to a maximum of 180 days from June 16, 2026 (December 13, 2026).

In accordance with s. 56 of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, S.C. 2002, c. 10, the issuance of the STR Licence requires your approval and as such, the NWB submits the attached Decision and Licence for your consideration.
