Dear Mr. Hohnstein,

This letter will confirm that the Hamlet of Pangnirtung has committed to undertake the following short term remedial work at the landfill. Work will begin as soon as weather permits and will be completed this summer.

A- Compact

We will compact and cover up all exposed organic and household waste in the landfill.

B – Segregation

We will segregate and construct berms with impermeable clay liners for the following waste streams:

- Hazardous Waste
- Honey bags, animal carcasses and sewage sludge

C- Municipal and bulky waste

We will also delineate a Municipal solid waste area for routine household garbage as well as a bulky waste area for white goods and other metal waste.

D – Commercial fish processing waste

We will excavate a pit in the landfill to capture all fish processing waste material.

E – Landfill fencing

We will work with the GN to ensure that the existing fencing is repaired.

F – Signage

The Hamlet will ensure that proper signage is in place at the landfill.

G – Additional remediation at the MSW site

- The existing bags of sewage sludge and fish processing wastes near the north wall of the MSW will be buried on site.
- The washout at the North West corner of the MSW will be repaired and any additional leaching or runoff will be controlled by a lined berm.
- We will construct a sump pit to accommodate leachate from the site and prevent any leachate from entering Pangnirtung Fjord.


H – Old sewage lagoon site

Crushed material will be dumped to prevent to prevent any sludge from entering Pangnirtung Fjord.

The Hamlet of Pangnirtung will work with the Department of Community and Government Services to ensure that all issues raised by the Nunavut Water Board are addressed in a timely fashion.
