Once we get this information from GN-CGS the application package can be sent for public review. I may think that O&M Manuals shall need to be updated, however, we would be able to include our requirements in addition to the public comments later on.

Hi Bhabesh,

When submitting the revised Application for 3BM-PAN please also include with the water usage item that the water taken from the Duval River to fill the reservoir would be less than 300 m3 per day to remain in the Type B territory.

With the assumption of 150 days for filling the reservoir and also assuming that no less than the annual usage water is taken from the river every year, you could be in the Type A territory. With the new Nunavut Water regulations the threshold for municipalities is also 300 m3 per day.

I hope it makes sense,
