### Comments:

#### A. Background

On October 28, 2014, the Nunavut Water Board (“**NWB**”) provided notification of the Hamlet of Pangnirtung's (the “**Licensee**”) Application for a modification request to its current Wastewater Treatment Plant under municipal water licence, #3BM-PAN1417. Mr. Bhabesh Roy, Municipal Planning Engineer, Community Government Services, Government of Nunavut submitted the modification request on behalf of the Hamlet of Pangnirtung.

Interested parties were asked to review this application and provide comments by November 12, 2014.

#### B. Results of Review

AANDC is satisfied at this time that the planned upgrades and modifications undertaken to the wastewater treatment plant will meet both the current and future needs of the Hamlet, while also ensuring that there are limited or no impacts to water or the environment.
