Good afternoon Richard. Below it states that comments regarding this project are due January 8, 2018. The following are comments from the Department of Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO):

The proposal is being reviewed to determine whether it is a work, undertaking or activity that results in serious harm to fish that are part of a commercial, recreational or Aboriginal fishery, or to fish that support such a fishery which is prohibited under subsection 35(1) of the *Fisheries Act*.

Based on the information provided, the Program is of the view that the proposal could potentially result in serious harm to fish. In order for us to complete a review of the proposal and determine whether serious harm to fish is likely, we ask that the proponent provides DFO with the following additional information:

- Updated pump station construction drawings.
