Remedial works were carried out in the pump house, water treatment plant and water storage tanks. This facility is licensed to CGS and being maintained by a CGS contractor on daily basis.

 Effluent is diluted to a certain extent. At present sewage from the Utilidor system is macerated and discharged to the ocean essentially untreated.

The RFP will be closed on January 27, 2012 to hire a consulting firm for detailed Design for the replacement of the existing Utilidor system. The design works will be started from this fiscal year 2012-13. The Poor and aged pipe lines will be replaced.

vii. a summary of any studies requested by the Board that relate to waste disposal, water use or reclamation, and a brief description of any future studies planned;

The studies on Nunavut wide solid waste was completed recently. Waiting for the direction from CGS Capital Planning. The design on the waste management of this Community was completed. The solid waste management site will be licensed to the Hamlet once built and commissioned.

The Hamlet of Resolute Bay is served entirely by the utilidor system with the exception of 14 facilities like RCMP building, Airport site and the polar shelf project along with other scattered buildings will remain on the trucked system. The Consultant is working on the optimization of the system for better services.

Airport Sewage Lagoon and present waste management are the concerns of the Nunavut Water Board. ED&T is holding the Airport Sewage Lagoon license. This particular license deals only Utilidor System.
