The research activity on NW Ellesmere Island is now completed. The new reseach activities will take place in 2016 on NW Axel Heiberg Island for which an "APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL FOR THE USE OF WATER OR DEPOSIT OF WASTE WITHOUT A LICENCE" has been filled out.			
8. ABANDONMENT MEASURES The following measures have been taken to address the final abandonment conditions required by the licence: (explain, with drawings, how abandonment conditions of the licence have been met; how stream channels have been rehabilitated; how tailings have been recontoured; how instream structures have been removed; and how waste materials have been disposed of. In 2013, we had a very small three person research project. We were on NW Ellesmere Island for three weeks only. We went to two different camp sites. All garbage and waste was either burned or shipped to Resolute for disposal. The small pits (30 x 30 cm wide) we dug out for grey water disposal were back filled, and the displaced dirt and stones were placed back on top in their original position. As the water we used came from meltting snow patches, no stream or creeks were recountoured. The water was scooped out using our own plastic water bottle: no mechanical equipment, such as a pump was used to either collect water or dispose of it. The camp sites were left in absolutely pristine conditions as we ensured our foot prints did not step over any vegetation, which is quite sparse in that area.
