I am please to announce you that the Arctic Bay Board of Hunters and Trappers Organization have approved your request for a Bowhead Whale Movement Study in the Admiralty Inlet area, to be conducted in August of 2008.

Arctic Bay HTO will provide two local Guides and two boats, and one local Assistant to support the project authority in the realization of the project. The rate of pay for the two Guides and the one Assistant is \$200.00 per day, and the cost per boat is \$250.00 per day. In the case of bad weather with no work at sea involved, the stand by rate for the two Guides is \$150.00 per day and \$100.00 per day for the one Assistant. All food and fuel should be provided by DFO project authority. The two Guides and one Assistant will provide their own tent and sleeping gears.

The Arctic Bay community boat will be available for you to transport people and equipment from the Arctic Bay community to your remote camp and back. We ask that you provide fuel for the use of the community boat.

The two Guides and one Assistant will be employed through the Arctic Bay HTO and a 10% administration fee will be charge on the total amount of the contract.
