<u>Subject: Admiralty Inlet Project – Water License Application</u>

Dear Mr. LeBlanc and Mr. Dueck:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB or Board") acknowledges your application dated July 24, 2008 and received on July 30, 2008, for a Type B water licence for a research camp located at Admiralty Inlet, in the Qikiqtani region of Nunavut. In processing this application, the NWB has determined that the time period for which the application was made has almost lapsed. Accordingly the NWB is returning your application.

To ensure adequate time for processing of future applications, the NWB recommends that an application be submitted at least 90 days prior to any planned commencement of water use or deposition of waste requiring a water licence. If the water use and/or the deposition of waste are likely to extend over several years, the NWB also encourages applicants to apply for a multi-year term.
